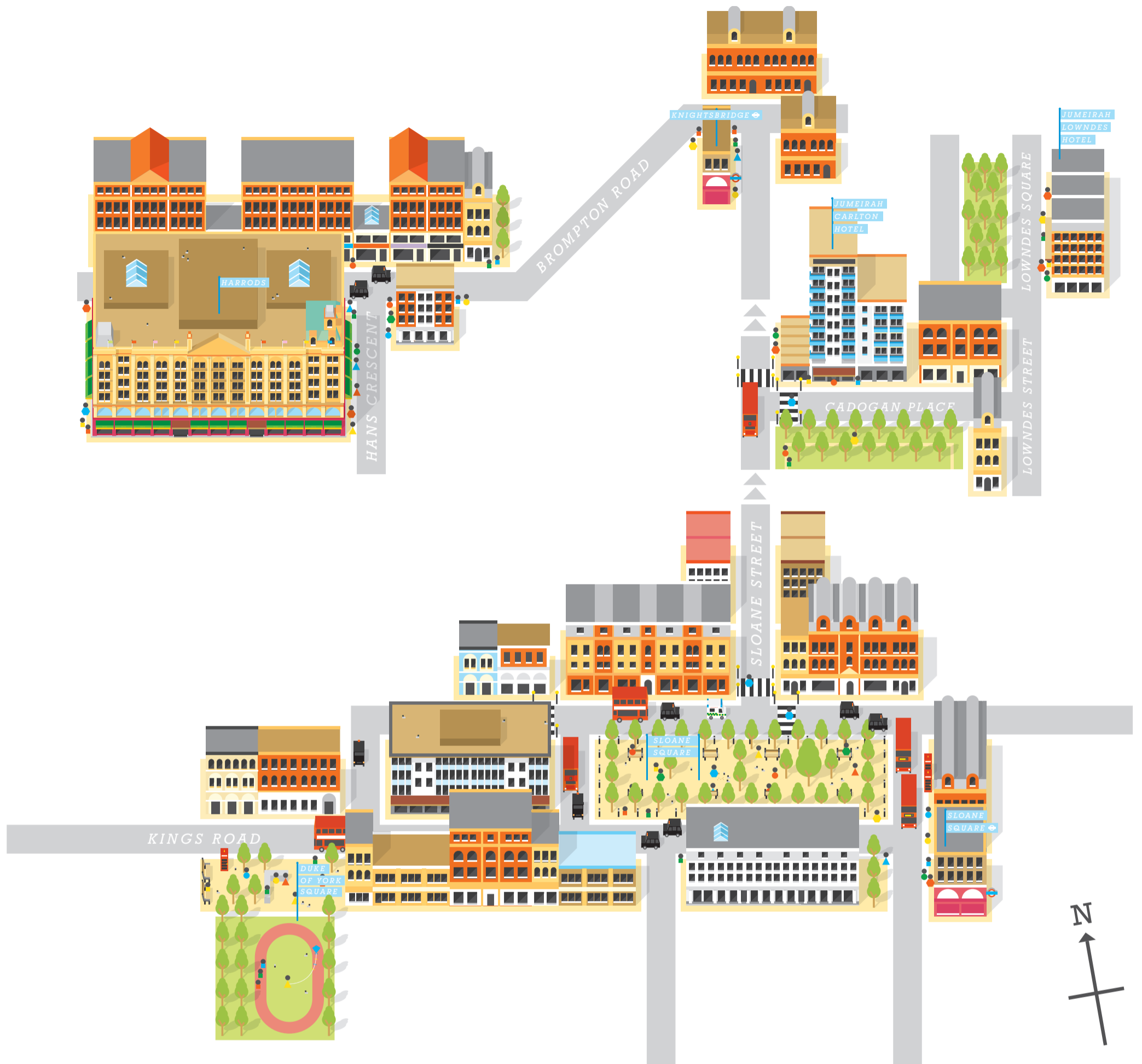


Egg Zone 3: Knightsbridge & Sloane Square
